For the second straight season, Lock Haven pitcher Kristen Erb was named as the "Pitcher of the Year" on the Daktronics, Inc., All-America squad, while Adams State shortstop Heather Ebert was selected as the "Player of the Year" on the second annual squad that is voted on by sports information directors in NCAA Division II.

Erb, a junior pitcher for the Lady Eagles, has a record of 42-7 with a 0.24 earned run average this season and has a three-year record of 117-12 heading into Friday's play at the NCAA Division II Championships. This year, Erb has thrown 332 innings with 401 strikeouts against just 19 walks, while holding opposing hitters to a .133 batting average.

She is joined on the first team in the circle by Barry's Amber Jack, who has the second-best ERA in the nation at 0.66 and Carson-Newman's Zoe Heim, who helped lead the Eagles to a school record 49 wins as she picked up 31 of them with a 1.04 ERA.

Ebert, a shortstop named as the top player in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference for the 2008 season, hit .505 with a Division II-high 22 home runs and 75 runs batted in. Her .978 slugging percentage ranks second in the nation and she was one of two Adams State player named to the first team, joining designated player selection Courtney Davis on the squad.

The rest of the infield includes Rollins first baseman Sherri Rabenold, Caldwell second baseman Gina Capardi and Lincoln Memorial third baseman Sara Henn.

Fort Hays State catcher Jessika Anastos, one of the top offensive catchers in Division II, was named as the first-team catcher after a season in which she batted .462 and posted an .835 slugging percentage. She is one of five hitters ranked among the top 20 in Division II in batting average that were named to the Daktronics first team.

Two of those top 20 hitters, North Dakota's Casie Hanson and Dowling's Taras Wallace were among the first team outfielders along with the lone freshman selected to this year's All-America squad, Mars Hill's Natalie Haithcox.

Hanson hit .534 – the third-best mark in the nation – while Wallace was a .457 hitter that led Division II in walks; she was also fourth in the country in doubles. Haithcox batted .428 in her first collegiate season with 11 home runs and 64 runs batted in.

The first team was rounded out by Kutztown's Ashley Fitzgerald at the utility player spot. Fitzgerald hit .434 on the season and teamed with third-team selection Steph Denliger to highlight one of the top one-two offensive punches in the nation, as the two combined for 32 home runs and 114 runs batted in.
